

# Jesus At This Time Was Doing His Father's Will

- He had just been baptized by His cousin, John the Baptist, Matthew 3:16
- At that moment, the Bible says, "the heavens were opened unto Him" and He saw the "Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon Him"
- God at that time said, "This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased."

# But Just After That Experience the Bible Says:

Jesus was, "led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil."

Hint: It wasn't the Devil

In the days of Jesus, it was a Dessert, a desolate, a difficult environment, a wasteland (kind of a solitary place, away from the hustle and bustle of life) definitely a difficult place to live!

#### **Adam**

In the Garden of Eden
Could Eat of 99% of trees
on the property where
he lived
Failed the test with a
Full Belly

#### **Christ**

In the Wilderness

Fasting 40 days

and nights

Passed the test

on an Empty

**Belly** 

"If you are the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread."

What is the Test here?

It's more than just eating bread.

Satan doesn't question Jesus'

ability, but His motive.



# Satan Tests a "Hungry Jesus" With His Own "Scriptural Interpretation!" Psalms 82:6-7

"I have said, Ye are gods;
And all of you are children of the most high.
But ye shall die like men,
And fall like one of the princes." Psalms 82:6-7

- Remember that Jesus, being a human, could die like a man as proven on Calvary's cross
- So Satan argues what harm would there be in exerting your privileged status as Son of God by performing a miracle on yourself, especially if <u>not</u> doing so could mean your own death
- Satan was trying to get Jesus to reject God's will and choose another path (that's what he does to us too!)

### Science

- For obvious moral reasons, there are not a lot of studies on how long a human being can fast
- Research suggest that 40 days is possible, and even up to 60 days, provided that the person is well hydrated (Maze Prison in Ireland, 1980-81; Dr. Michael Peel, British Medical Journal, 1997)
- When you stop eating, the body begins to use up what you have already stored (fats, carbohydrates, and proteins)

## He Makes a Short Cut Look Very Good!

- "It's okay to cheat on your taxes, besides people do it all the time and you really need the money!"
- "It's okay to sleep with a potential marriage candidate of yours, though not married. Besides, how are you going to compete with the other folks if you don't give it up! Your time is running out!"
- "It's okay to curse a little, to let folks know when you mean business, and to get off of your case!"

#### The Point:

Satan wants us to sin by lusting after our own <u>physical</u> <u>lives</u> as being more important than obeying God!

# The Other Idea Behind Satan's Suggestion Was To Get Jesus To Doubt If God Cared About Him!

"Since you are God's Son, Why doesn't He feed you?"

"If you belong to Him, why did He lead you into this wilderness to die?"



"Here you are doing your Father's will and you get treated like this!" (Same argument to Job and us)

# The Question That We Have To Face Like Jesus Is This One:

## Can We Not Trust God To Meet Our Physical Needs While We Obey Him?

"Are not two sparrows sold for a penny? Yet not one of them will fall to the ground outside of your Father's care? And even the very hairs on your head are all numbered. So don't be afraid; ye are worth more than many sparrows." Matt. 10:29-31

### Jesus Trusted God!

- Jesus obeyed His Father, and trusted His Father to take care of Him, even when He was physically weak, Matthew 4:11, "Then the devil left Him, and the angels came and attended (ministered to)him." (Have you ever received blessings in your life from angels you never knew existed?)
- He trusted in His Father by continuing to fast as long as it was His will and rejected Satan's suggested path
  - "If I take care of God's spiritual needs in my life, he will take care of me." (Phil 4:19)
